
How the Community Security Initiative Assists Institutions within Greater MetroWest.

During 2021, the Chief Security Officer (Bob Wilson) assisted:

76 institutions 107 times



60% of the institutions requested assistance with threat assessments.





#### **Threat Assessments:**

Threat assessments involved **vandalism**, **emails**, **social media postings**, **interrupted video-conferencing**, **flyers posted**, **letters received**, **phone calls**, **and verbal harassment** which often included displays of hate symbols and anti-Semitic messages. The most common incidents assessed were expressed threats, implied threats and vandalism.

#### During 2021, Bob Wilson conducted 65 threat assessments.



**64%** of the partner agencies' threat assessments were located in Morris county.










#### **Threat Assessments:**


#### 75% increase in antisemitic threats from 2020.



"Other" institutions received the most antisemitic threats in 2020 & 2021.




In **2021 Union** county had the **most antisemitic** threats whereas in 2020 it was Essex county.






### **Physical Assessments:**






#### **Bob Wilson assisted**

#### 100% of institutions that Bob Wilson assisted received a state grant.


11 synagogues & 3 partner agencies/Jewish non-profits received \$420,000 in non-profit security grants.






### The preparedness of our synagogues and partner agencies:

Synagogues and partner agencies are **concerned** about the **security of their institutions.** 




73% of institutions had a security assessment in the last 3 years.

58% of institutions have Emergency Operations Procedures.\*




65% of institutions have a committee for security planning.\*






### The preparedness of our synagogues and partner agencies:

47% of institutions budget for security personnel & equipment.\*




56% of institutions fund their security personnel & equipment from dues.\*






### The preparedness of our synagogues and partner agencies:
