Overview:

From the rhythm of the tango to the majestic beauty of Iguazú Falls, Argentina comes alive on this unforgettable Major Gifts Mission with Jewish Federation of Greater MetroWest NJ. Experience the energy and vitality of Latin American life through an immersive journey exploring Argentina's culture, history, and vibrant Jewish community.

The mission includes:

- 6 nights hotel stay: 4 nights in Buenos Aires and 2 nights near Iguazú Falls
- Most meals & wine with group dinners
- Programming, touring & entrance fees
- Flight to Iguazú Falls
- All gratuities
- Professional team: 2–3 Federation professionals, local tour guide, expert educator, and security guard (in Buenos Aires)

Not Included:

- Airfare to and from Argentina.
- Alcohol - except for wine at dinners
- **Travel Insurance- required.** To protect yourself in the event of cancellation and any medical issues in Argentina

UJA Annual Campaign:

- We welcome donors making \$10,000, individual or household (\$5,000 for NextGen Donors, ages 25-45) to the 2027 UJA Annual Campaign

Food and Beverage:

- Breakfast daily at hotel
- Lunch and dinner included except for 2 lunches and 1 free night in Buenos Aires
- In Argentina, we will not be able to provide Kosher meals. Vegetarian entrees will be available at every meal. No non-kosher items (treif – such as pork or shellfish or mixing milk and meat) will be served.

Shabbat:

- Transportation on Shabbat will be limited to essential group travel to the synagogue for Friday night services and dinner with the local Jewish community (the distance is too far to walk).
- On Shabbat day, activities will be walking tours.

Extensions:

- Our tour company, J2, can help you plan pre- and post-trip extensions. Please let us know if you are interested and we can make the connection.

Physical Requirements:

- This mission includes long days and extensive walking/standing. Participants should be able to walk at a steady pace for several miles, manage stairs and uneven surfaces, and be comfortable being active throughout the day.

Mission Cost:

- \$8,375 per person*
- Land only
- Double room
- Single supplement of \$1,600

*Based on 20-29 participants. 30 or more participants reduces the cost by \$900/person.

Registration:

- Please register by June 30, 2026

Payment for the mission:

- Deposit of \$1,000 at registration, by credit card only.
- Final payment is due by November 6, by credit card or wire transfer

NOTE: Do not purchase travel insurance or book flights until we confirm that we have the minimum number of 20 participants
